Meal Account Balances

Each child participating in the USD320 meal program must maintain a positive balance in his/her meal account. When a parent/sponsor registers a student, they enter into an agreement with USD320 Food Service to ensure that the account balance remains positive.

Payments brought to school will be deposited before and after the school lunch meal and will not be allowed during lunch service. If a student has reduced their account to a zero balance; the student will lose the privilege of using their account to purchase ala carte items until payment is made.

Ala Carte Privileges

In addition to the school meals offered daily at breakfast and lunch, WMS and WHS offer a variety of ala carte food choices that may be purchased during meal times. Students must return a signed parental permission slip before ala carte purchases may be made from their lunch accounts. It is the family's responsibility to help students budget their money spent in addition to school meals.
