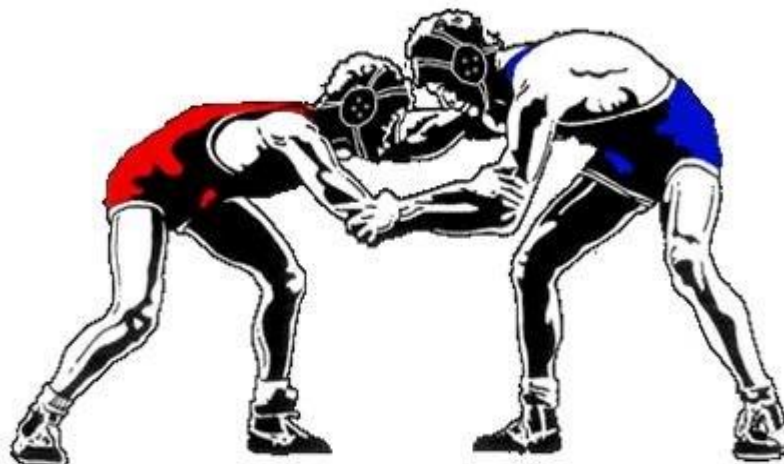

Citizenship/Sportsmanship Rule 52

All actions are to be for, not against, positive, not negative or disrespectful

SECTION 1: GENERAL REGULATIONS (APPLIES TO GRADES 7 – 12)

Article 1: Sportsmanship:

Is a general way of thinking and behaving. The following sportsmanship policy items are listed below for clarification:

- A. Be courteous to all (participants, coaches, officials, staff and fans).
- B. KNOW THE RULES, ABIDE BY AND RESPECT THE OFFICIAL'S DECISIONS.
- C. Win with character and lose with dignity.
- D. Display appreciation for good performance regardless of the team.
- E. Exercise self-control and reflect positively upon yourself, team & school.
- F. Permit only positive sportsman like behavior to reflect on your school or its activities.

Article 2: Enforcement Procedure:

It is encouraged and recommended by the Kansas State High School Activities Association, (KSHSAA), that local board of education adapt these regulations and reinforce them as indicated. The Executive Board of KSHSAA shall be responsible for the interpretation of these REGULATIONS, INCLUDING "DESIRABLE" AND UNACCEPTABLE "BEHAVIOR" AND SHALL PUBLISH THEM IN THE ASSOCIATION'S CITIZENSHIP/SPORTSMANSHIP MANUAL.
