 USD 320 has lifted the mask mandate as of May 25, 2021 due to the extreme decrease in numbers of positive cases in our area per County data. The number and severity of cases will be closely monitored. If necessary, the mask mandate reinstituted.
- (B) Modifying facilities to allow for physical distancing (e.g., use of cohorts/podding).USD 320 will transfer to regular distancing at the start of the school year.
- (C) Handwashing and respiratory etiquette. Hand sanitizer and facial tissues will continue to be provided and available. Covering of mouth and nose when sneezing will be encouraged a well as regular hand washing.
- (D) Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including improving ventilation.Enhanced cleaning of facilities will be continued.
- (E) Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the State, local, territorial, or Tribal health departments.
 - Contact tracing, etc. will be done on an as needed basis when dictated by the County Health Department.
- (F) Diagnostic and screening testing.This is be provided as necessary or required.

- (G) Efforts to provide vaccinations to school communities.
 USD 320 will work with local health officials to provide as they are available.
- (H) Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies.
 Appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to health and safety will continue to take place.
- (I) Coordination with State and local health officials.

 USD 320 will continue regular meetings with the county health department.
