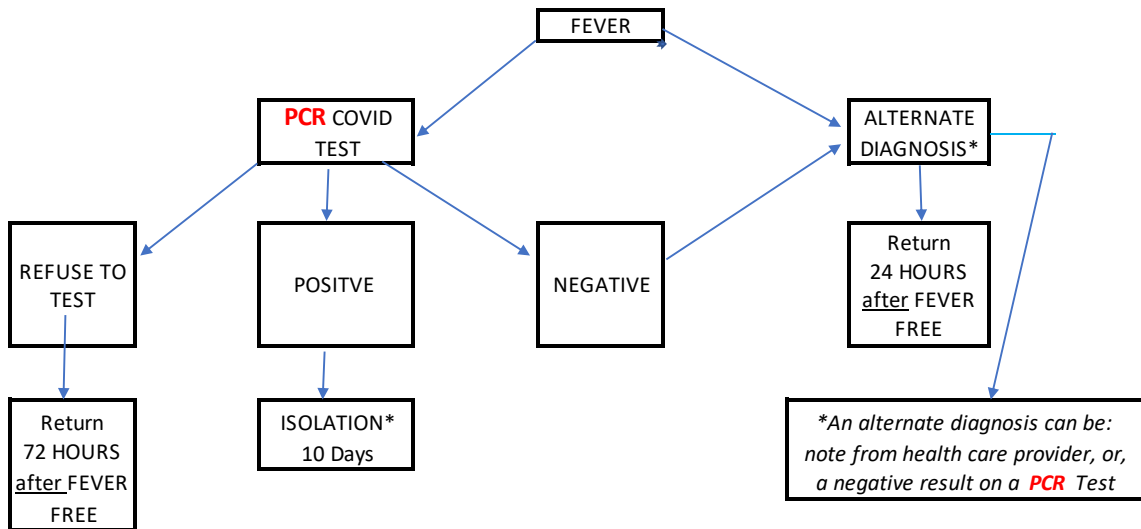


When determining whether or not a student should be sent home due to covid-similar symptoms, the following chart will be utilized as guidance by the Wamego Schools.

- (1) One symptom, NO fever = Nurse's judgement; can encourage covid testing
- (2) Two or more symptoms, but NO fever = Strongly ENCOURAGE covid testing
- (3) Fever = send home and utilize Fever Flow Chart:

With or without a fever, if a symptom is loss of taste or smell. . .automatic send home, strongly encourage testing.



COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Infected people have had a wide range of symptoms
Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Congestion or runny nose
- Cough
- Diarrhea
- Difficulty breathing; shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Fever or chills
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Muscle or body aches
- Nausea or vomiting
- Sore throat
