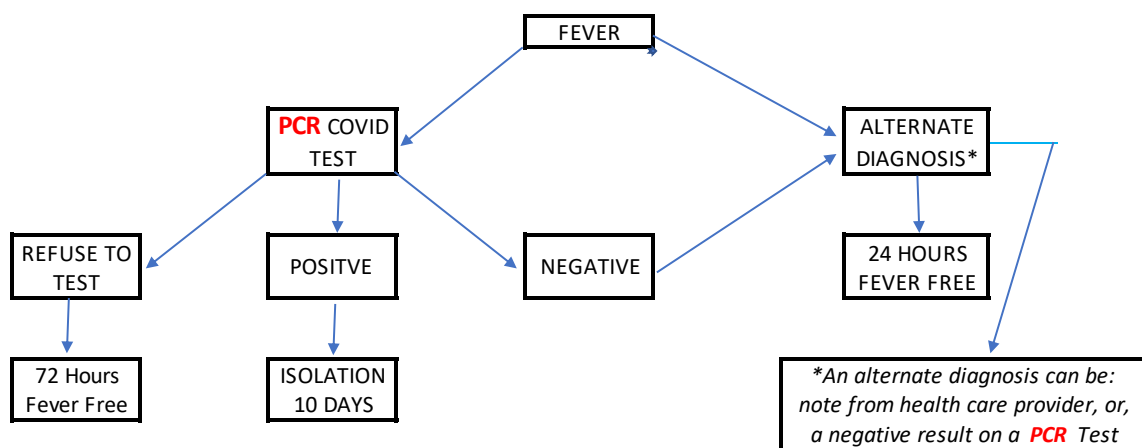


**When determining whether or not a student should be sent home due to covid-similar symptoms, the following chart will be utilized as guidance by the Wamego Schools.**

- (1) One symptom, NO fever = Nurse's judgement; can encourage covid testing
- (2) Two or more symptoms, but NO fever = Strongly ENCOURAGE covid testing
- (3) Fever = send home and utilize Fever Flow Chart:



COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Infected people have had a wide range of symptoms  
Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
